

Motion Title:

To Set Limits Between Meetings

To Amend:

Assumption of one-hour schedule for meetings

Current:

Meetings on Zoom1 and Zoom2 are assumed to be one-hour in length, needing VIG to extend that length.

Proposed:

It is proposed that meetings on both Zoom1 and Zoom2 can extend beyond one-hour length to 90 minutes or less, without the need for VIG approval. Upon reaching 90 minutes, the meeting space shall be vacated, to allow the next meeting to prepare.

Primary Purpose:

To allow meetings that so desire to extend to up to 90 minutes in length, when and if needed, without prior VIG approval.

Intent:

To avoid extra work for Meetings Committee and make clear the boundary between meetings.

Rationale:

It would be a better utilization of our two Zoom platforms to allow meetings to extend to up to 90 minutes, which would afford members at those meetings additional time for sharing and/or parking lot fellowship. Our meeting schedule as written provides 2-hour increments: this proposed Motion will take better advantage of those increments.
