## MOTION: Elections of Board Members

Move to amend [OAFS Policy & Procedure Manual](#) {Nov.11 2020} by amending the following.

<b>CURRENT WORDING</b>	<b>PROPOSED WORDING</b>
<p>1. Nominations must be made from the floor at the time of the election.</p> <p>a. A member may nominate themselves.</p> <p>b. All nominations must receive a second.</p> <p>2. Elections will be held <del>quarterly</del>.</p> <p>3. Each Board member is elected for a <del>three (3) month</del> term.</p> <p>4. Board members shall serve no more than <del>four (4)</del> consecutive terms in the same position, whenever possible.</p> <p>5. After an interval of one (1) year, Board members may again be eligible for election to their prior office.</p> <p>6. In the event that there is no candidate for a vacant office, the current officer may serve an additional one (1) month until the next scheduled OAFSVIG business meeting, at which point an additional election will be held to fill the position.</p> <p>7. In the case that any officer position becomes vacant between elections, a special business meeting may be called for the purpose of a group conscience to establish an existing OAFSVIG member as a temporary officer in the position until the next scheduled business meeting.</p> <p>a. A person chosen to fill any vacancy on the board shall meet the qualifications as defined in Article IV, Section 3 of the OAFSVIG Bylaws, and Article VIII and IX of this Policy &amp; Procedure Manual.</p> <p>8. Voting will be by ballot defined as follows for the purpose of Zoom:</p>	<p>1. Nominations must be made from the floor at the time of the election.</p> <p>a. A member may nominate themselves.</p> <p>b. All nominations must receive a second.</p> <p>2. Elections will be held <u>yearly</u>.</p> <p>3. Each Board member is elected for a <u>one-year</u> term.</p> <p>4. Board members shall serve no more than <u>two (2)</u> consecutive terms in the same position, whenever possible.</p> <p>5. After an interval of one (1) year, Board members may again be eligible for election to their prior office.</p> <p>6. In the event that there is no candidate for a vacant office, the current officer may serve an additional one (1) month until the next scheduled OAFSVIG business meeting, at which point an additional election will be held to fill the position.</p> <p>7. In the case that any officer position becomes vacant between elections, a special business meeting may be called for the purpose of a group conscience to establish an existing OAFSVIG member as a temporary officer in the position until the next scheduled business meeting.</p> <p>a. A person chosen to fill any vacancy on the board shall meet the qualifications as defined in Article IV, Section 3 of the OAFSVIG Bylaws, and Article VIII and IX of this Policy &amp; Procedure Manual.</p> <p>8.
