MOTION: Change OAF Bylaws Article 10 , Section 5 as follows:

<u>CURRENT:</u>	<u>PROPOSED:</u>
5. All proposed amendments must be communicated in writing on the website or by electronic mail at least thirty (30) days prior to the voting meeting.	5. All proposed amendments must be communicated in writing on the website or by electronic mail at least thirty (30) twenty (20) days prior to the voting meeting.

INTENT:

To shorten the time period proposed motions need to be posted on the Footsteps website. To eliminate the choice of communicating the proposed amendment through email.

IMPLEMENTATION: The intergroup will follow this new rule.

PRIMARY PURPOSE AND RATIONALE: Currently it can be impossible to get a motion that was written during the intergroup meeting to be considered at the next meeting since often there is less than 30 days between meetings. When it takes months for motions to be considered because of this strict rule, it interferes with the intergroup's ability to do business.

Since it is not possible to email all the interested members a proposed motion, we want to remove this implausibility.
